

CCHS Dress Code

Coastal Christian High School's dress code is intended to promote modesty resulting in an atmosphere that limits distractions and enhances learning.

The following guidelines must be followed during the school day hours of 8:25 - 3:30.

TOPS

- CCHS issued t-shirts are encouraged and permitted at any time on campus. No alterations are to be made to any CCHS issued t-shirt.
- All shirts must have sleeves and a collar unless it is a CCHS issued t-shirt.
- Collared shirts with sleeves are permitted in any color or pattern but cannot be sheer or "see-through."
- Button-up shirts must have a sleeve and collar and button up high enough to cover all undergarments.
- Sweatshirts, hoodies, and jackets are permitted. If they are removed, a CCHS t-shirt must be underneath.
- Sweaters **MUST** be crew-neck and cannot be "see-through" or open weave.
- Tops must be long enough to cover midribs even when arms are raised.
- Tops may **NOT** display inappropriate wording or graphics.
- Clothing of any type promoting a political agenda or activism is **NOT** permitted on campus.
- **SENIORS ONLY** may wear crew neck t-shirts bearing the logo of the colleges or universities from which they have received an official letter of acceptance.

BOTTOMS

- Male pants and shorts must have a zipper, and button or snap closure.
- Pants may be any color or pattern but must **NOT** have rips or tears higher than five inches above the knee.
- All shorts, male or female, must have an inseam that measures at least five inches.
- Athletic shorts, athletic pants, bathing suits/board shorts, and leggings are **NOT** permitted in the building during the school day.
- PE and weight training classes will have designated clothing to be changed into and worn only during the class period and not throughout the school building.

DRESSES/SKIRTS

- Maxi length dresses and skirts are the only skirt length permitted during the school day.
- Maxi-dresses must have a collar and sleeve built into the dress and cover undergarments including camisoles and tank tops.
- Rompers are **NOT** permitted during the school day.

FOOTWEAR

- Any type of footwear is permitted except for bedroom slippers.

HATS/HOODS

- No hats are permitted during the school day inside the building.
- Hoods on jackets and hoodies may **NOT** be up and covering a student's head inside the building.

Extracurricular Activities

- Unless otherwise specified, appropriate apparel as outlined above should be worn for **ALL** trips and athletics. Athletes should also consult the athletic handbook for practice and game day attire.
- Students **attending** an extracurricular event should pursue modesty in their attire. The CCHS administration reserves the right to ask any student in attendance to change his or her clothing if it is deemed immodest.

The CCHS administration reserves the right to send any student home to change his or her clothing, jewelry, hairstyle, etc. if administration deems it to be a distraction, immodest, or outside of the above guidelines.
